APO Internal Marina Operations

- 1. Gate to be locked at all times
 - a. Do not leave gate unlocked and open without APO personnel on site at the Marina
 - b. Personnel are to park in the parking area and walk down to the Marina leaving the gate locked unless launching a boat or mowing the grass
 - c. If moving, open gate to get equipment in and lock immediately

2. Launching

- a. Property Owner/Agent Schedule an appointment through PSO
 - i. Appointment days/times: F-M 8AM-8PM as daylight allows.
- Boat/Trailer inspection is to be done in the parking area before opening gate.
- c. Snap a picture of the boat, with the lot number clearly visible.
- d. Launch Inspection Form filled out and signed
- e. Discussion of Invasive Species and packet given, if needed
- f. Explain new procedure for removal and re-launch during season
- 3. Temporary Removal before end of season
 - a. Question why, use Temporary Boat Removal Form
 - b. Reiterate new temporary removal procedure
 - c. If owner is removing boat on own trailer attach inspection tag a note tag number on the form
 - d. If agent is removing boat on commercial trailer the agent must sign a Confirmation form attesting to the fact that the boat will not be entering another body of water prior to re-launching into SHL.
 - e. Have form signed by owner/agent and officer
 - i. Copy stays at PSO for use upon re-launch
 - ii. Copy goes to APO after re-launch
- 4. Re-Launch of Boat before end of season
 - a. Boat/Trailer inspection
 - b. Launch Inspection Form filled out and signed
 - c. Confirmation that the inspection tag is in place (confirm tag number)
 - i. If the inspection tag is not in place find out why and require either:
 - Letter from a marina is required stating why the boat had to be removed from the trailer with assurance given in the letter that the boat was not put into another body of water
 - 2. If no letter is provided, the boat and trailer must be pressure washed with hot soapy water and remain out of the lake for 7-days. NO EXCEPTIONS. Boat re-launch date to be noted in C3

- 3. Inform the owner that the car washes in Catskill and Coxsackie are available for pressure washing
- 5. Permanent Removal
 - a. Fill out Permanent Removal form
 - b. Owner and Officer sign
 - c. If owner is removing boat on own trailer attach inspection tag a note tag number on the form
 - d. If agent is removing boat on commercial trailer the agent must sign a Confirmation form attesting to the fact that the boat will not be entering another body of water prior to re-launching into SHL or make arrangements for the owner to supply a Confirmation letter

Dear,

I am writing to inform you that Zebra Mussels have been found in Sleepy Hollow Lake. We have 3 known species of invasive plants and are disheartened to discover that we now have mussels.

As you know, only property owners that have registered their boats with the APO are allowed to launch boats into our lake. We are a private community and as such have the authority and power to stop others from entering the lake. All boats are inspected by our staff prior to entry for signs of any invasive species that may be attached to the trailer or lurking on or in any parts of the boat, including live wells, etc.

In an effort to remain free of the other invasive species, in particular, Quagga Mussels, Asian Clams and the flea, we are increasing our restrictions on what can enter our lake and how we will allow boats to exit the lake and re-launch during the regular season.

Please find attached our new Marina Operations. There are several changes that may affect how you launch boats for our community members. For example, If you will be using your own trailer to remove boats from SHL, be advised that Marinas and other agents cannot use a trailer that has been in other bodies of water, including the Hudson River. **There will be no exceptions**. It is our suggestion that you designate one trailer for use in Sleepy Hollow Lake only in order to avoid any delay in your busy schedules.
